The hull is built around a Metallic Bulkhead forward of the mast and carbon bulkhead throughout; The sandwich is as follow .Core of 4 ply of 4mm Mahogany then carbon and epoxy; Baked in oven at 80°C

Teak deck of 6mm on a Marine ply and epoxy support.
