Bianca Yachts, based in Rudkøbing, Denmark, built some of the most solid GRP yachts of the 1970s–1980s. The Bianca 414 is a flagship example of their Scandinavian quality and aesthetic clarity.

Architects: Paul Elvström & Jan Kjærulff

Designed by the legendary team of Paul Elvström (four-time Olympic champion) and Jan Kjærulff, the Bianca 414 features all the hallmarks of great Nordic yacht design: low freeboard, clean flush deck long, elegant bow, narrow, fast hull.
