Description

Boat put up for sale by its owner. Visits on request.

Built in 1983 by Jeanneau, the hull of the Sun Shine 36 is designed by Tony Castro in a racing spirit. However, the interior fittings provide a real comfort of life on board for the cruise. Since her purchase in December 2023, I have been constantly renovating this boat named Nausicaä. As a professional sailor, I worked with rigor and zeal on this renovation which cost me nearly €25,000 in equipment and a year of work where I did not count my hours. My goal was to make it a high-performance, pleasant and durable boat.

Here is a list of the projects undertaken:

Electricity

- Wiring completely redone
- Changed lighting fixtures
- Change of the battery fleet and upgrading to standards
- Installation of a 200Watt solar panel and power regulator
- 220V circuit throughout the boat operating at dock or via converter

Ventilation

- Installation of a complete ventilation system via cooling fans
- Installation of suction and evacuation ducts in the machine room

Isolation

- Inner shell completely exposed
- Projection of cork on the walls (Soliège)
- Gluing cork plates on top

Goods & Wood

- Installation of fixing brackets on all the walls
- Custom-made creation of light wood flooring varnished at the time
- Installation of new linings
- Sanding and resurfacing of interior wood

Saddlery

- Cutting of new foams

Custom-made water-repellent fabric covers for the square and linen for the bunks

Plumbing

Change of the bilge pump

Creation of a shower water drainage circuit

Replacement of electric pumps for seawater and fresh water

Kitchen

Replacement of the stove-oven on cardant

Led starter battery about 50A and 2 service batteries AGM 90A each changed in 2024. All batteries charge through engine's alternator with a charge repartitor, or with solar panel associated with its bluetooth regulator, or using the land current from the harbor. 200W solar panel installed on the stainless steel superstructure. And its bluetooth regulator (Victron). Room for a second solar panel if needed. 12V and 220V electric circuits in the whole boat. Need to replace the Converter to have 220V at sea. But works in the harbor. 220V inlet and cable to connect the boat to mainland electric outlet. Ventilation Multitude of computer fans hidden in all rooms to generate air flow. Lights All on LED

On the roof, two winch classic on port side and starboard side.

Everything that follows has been changed in 2024

- Mainsail trolley with manouvering sheave and blockers
- Genoa trolleys with manouvering sheave and blockers
- 10 cam cleat 8-16mm (5 on each side of the roof)
- 2 sheave box on each side of the roof to bring all sheets from mast to cockpit

Description Of Boat Equipment

All portlights and plexiglass have been changed by new ones in 2024.

Each rear cabine has two opening portlights allowing a nice air-flow from cockpit to deck.

An opening portlight above the cooking stove evacuate cooking smells. And one above captain's table allow his/her head to cool while thinking.
